

Photography Tour Chinatown - with Boris Mar

During a 3 hour session we will do a tour through Chinatown and explore the best photo-opportunities in this unique part of Singapore. We will be scouting for iconic architecture, traditional shops, cozy little streets and of course the friendly locals.

Throughout the tour I will be giving tips on :

- What to look for?
- Where to position yourself to get creative framing options?
- Recommendations on camera setting to get the best results?
- Unlike Photography Workshop, there won't be any focus on teaching actual photography skills.

No doubt you will be bringing back some stunning photographs.

Everybody is welcome to join! There is no requirement for a specific camera equipment or pre-required photography knowledge. However, to get the most of the tour I would recommend the following (in order of priority) :

- Know how to adjust aperture and shutter speed of your camera
- Know how to adjust focus (manual or automatic) of your camera
- Know how to adjust ISO of your camera
- Bring multiple lenses if you have them (zoom and wide angle)
- Bring a tripod

Practical info:

- Spoken language during the tour will be English.
- Start : 9am. Entrance to the Buddha Tooth Relic Temple, 288 South Bridge Road.
- Finish : 12am. Wherever the photo-opportunities end up bringing us. But definitely somewhere in Chinatown.
