

Starting point:

Somerset MRT station exit B

Follow the signs

313@Somerset/Orchard road until you get to the ground floor of Somerset mall

Walk straight ahead towards Orchard Road

Cross Orchard road and turn right

Take the first left (Emerald Hill Road = start of the walking tour

This very nice walk through the city centre will guide you past some nice places and hidden gems that can be found in Singapore. Starting at Emerald Hill road you will discover traditional Peranakan Houses across Orchard road. After this you will make your way to Fort Canning. From there the tour will guide you further through the city centre and will end at Cavenagh Bridge.



Practical:

- Total walking distance: approx. 8 km
- Duration: depends on your pace and competitiveness but you can expect to do this within 3 to 4 hours. You can always split up the walk and complete the search in several days.
- Difficulty: easy (note that there is one big stair climb up at Fort Canning Park. (bypass the staircase at Fort Canning via the street towards the hotel)
- Eating and food: During the hike you can stop at any point to get refreshments and breaks.
- Paved/unpaved: 100 % of the walking will be on paved ground. This walking search can be done by foot and with buggies

Pictures and Route:

You will be provided with several photos along the walking tour. You will need to find the location where the picture was taken and answer the question related to that picture.

The pictures aren't taken in a chronological order but the start of each new search area is indicated (f.i. see below [Pictures@Emerald Hill loop](#)).
