

## ***Photography workshop Singapore - Chasing the Light with Boris Mar***

Photography is my passion! For the last 20 years I have used most of my free time trying to capture unique images from around the globe. Mostly inspired by Mother Nature, I have captured some unique moments with my camera. However, every single image captured has always been the result of a combination of elements ;

- my eagerness to find that unique place, vista or situation to capture on camera
- a strong understanding of the technical capabilities of my camera
- and most importantly, Mother Nature's unique, and often rare display of beauty.

During a 3 hour session I will share my experiences with you. Through an interactive, hands-on photography workshop you will be able to get your photography skills to the next level. The workshop is targeted towards beginners and intermediate level. In other words, join with open expectations. Part of the workshop will either be too basic or too advanced. The other part will be just perfect for you. But rest assured; next time you go on a holiday, you will bring back some stunning images.

Content :

- Learn the basics of a proper exposure (Aperture, Shutter Speed, Iso Range).
- Learn the rules of a strong composition.
- How to take a land/cityscape photograph at sunset and dusk. Capturing magic light.
- Experimenting with long exposures for surreal effects.
- How to capture abstracts and details.

Practical info:

- The course will be done in English.
- Start : Gardens by the Bay. We meet at the entrance of the Flower Dome. 5:00pm.
- Finish : To be determined. But somewhere within walking distance of the Flower Dome.
- Note that we will be photographing till about 30 minutes after sunset. Sunset is at 7:11pm.

What to bring!

Required:

- Digital camera and lens.
- People with a compact digital camera are welcome to join as well.
- Charged camera battery and empty SD/CF card.
- Rain coat
- Walking shoes
- Bottle of water and snack
- Mosquito Repellent
- Eagerness to learn

Preferred :

- Tripod. This is highly advisable. For those who don't have a tripod ; you can buy a cheap one online for anywhere between \$15 and \$50. It's worth bringing it to the workshop! Below are some links where you can buy one online. Please note however, "you get what you pay for".
